SAVANNA FUMC ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MINUTES SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2024 11:30AM CHURCH LIBRARY

Vice-chairperson Bill Wright called the meeting to order with members Tom Michels, Mary Irons, Molly Andersen, Deeann Kramer, Kris Yingling, Kathie and Burt Prins, Ronda Rathje, Esther Losh, Linda Stubbe, Jason Moore, and Vivian Eaton present. Mary opened the meeting with prayer. Minutes from the previous meeting were emailed to members. Mary moved, seconded by Jason, to accept the minutes as presented and the motion passed. Financial reports were handed out. Overall January was a good month financially. The kitchen remodeling bill appears on this month's report. Vivian had several questions for the yearly s tatistical report.

TRUSTEES: After an inspection of the boiler a leaking gasket was discovered and will be fixed. There are still questions about the heat trace on the church roof. There is a loose hinge on the kitchen pass-through. A new committee will be formed to get information on a new electrical sign for the church.

FINANCE: The next meeting is March 12th at 5pm. There will also be a discussion of how to grow our church. Deeann mentioned having a marketing plan for the church. We need to focus on mission and bringing people to Jesus.

WORSHIP: We tried a new policy this morning with 2 ushers in the sanctuary handing out bulletins, a greeter at the sanctuary door, and 1 person in the narthex taking attendance, hoping this will help lessen the crowd in the narthex before worship. March communion offering will go to the rice-meal packing event in April. We will have a sunrise service on Easter morning. It was suggested we share our joys during Joys and Concerns and pass a microphone around again. New signs are needed in the church building for the kitchen, office, restrooms, and sanctuary.

EDUCATION: Pretzel Sunday will be March 10th. Easter eggs will be out soon for members to fill. A female chaperone is still needed for the youth mission trip this summer.

EVANGELISM: Janis Wilt has moved to Peoria. Ancil Guilinger's funeral was yesterday.

OUTREACH: The Souper Bowl luncheon last week raised \$465 for the youth mission trip. There was some discussion about their budget and paying for the GriefShare program. The committee has not been asked to pay for the program.

UWF: The members served the funeral luncheon yesterday. March's meeting will be the Prayer and Self-Denial program presented by Molly. They are planning a dinner in April.

UMM: They are meeting Tuesday.

INTERCHURCH COUNCIL: The weekly Lenten service is at the Presbyterian church with Pastor Dave preaching. VBS is planning this year's program, Camp Firelight. It will be held July 15-19, 2024.

YOUTH: We need a new representative.



Ronda estimated the total cost to be around \$600.


The meeting was adjourned at 12:14pm.
