During the 2022 VBS, we served 44 kids every day with 15 youth helpers and 12 adult helpers. We have been working hard to make safe places for our children and youth. So, please send your kids or grandkids to FUMC. We will be taking very good care of them in God's love and care. As you know, they need each other. They are going to learn from each other.

Here is very important news regarding a new school term. School Supplies will be distributed in our fellowship hall on 8/1 (Mon) and 8/15 (Mon) from 3:30pm to 6:00pm. Parents and kids should come together to get food, basic necessaries, and school supplies at the same time. Please, get the word out to the public who need it. FUMC takes care of our local community and its members.



As I have announced it in July, our women's bathroom and men's bathroom have been updated. Women's room has three new toilets and men's room has new faucets on the washing basin and drain parts underneath. We have not had any problems during our VBS with using our bathrooms. Praise be to God! The kitchen committee has been created and now working very hard to get some ideas to remodel our kitchen area. Also, the trustee committee has been contacting local businesses to fix our metal roof leaking. It should be done quickly before another winter comes. I believe that our church leaders have been working very hard to maintain our church building and reach out to the local community. Let us continue to serve others with what God has given to us. Please, continue to support us and pray for our new projects!








We received a very nice Thank you card and a generous donation of \$150 from UCC for using our church for Vacation Bible School.











SAVANNA FUMC ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MINUTES

SUNDAY, JUNE 19, 2022 10:30am

CHURCH LIBRARY

Chairperson Susan Michelle Jepsen called the meeting to order with members Noah Johnson, Kathie Prins, Kris Yingling, Tom Michels, Molly Andersen, Mary Irons, and Pastor Dave Yim present, at 10:35am. Pastor Dave opened the meeting with prayer. Minutes from the previous meeting were emailed to members. A correction was made under the Outreach segment to read 1800 packets, which is 10,800 meals. Susan Michelle moved, seconded by Kathie, to accept the minutes as corrected and the motion passed.

FINANCE: We received a check for \$104,782.47 from the Paul Brunner estate and expect another check for \$43,000. \$15,000 was deposited into our checking account and the balance was deposited into the savings account. Several ideas were presented on possible projects funded by this gift, including solar panels, resurfacing the church parking lot, fixing the church roof and updating the women's restroom. Will Johnson has submitted a bid for replacing the toilets in the women's restroom and fixing a leak in the boiler for approximately \$2500. Tom moved, seconded by Susan Michelle, to spend up to \$5000 to fix the leak and remodel the restroom and the motion passed. The July communion offering will be designated for VBS.

TRUSTEES: We have not received any bids yet on the church roof repair. We will contact ProTect Metal in Mt Carroll for a bid. 2 members from the Memorial committee attended the Trustee meeting to discuss forming a kitchen committee, under the Trustees committee, and some remodeling of the narthex and fellowship hall. Members suggested for the kitchen committee are Deeann Kramer, Mary Irons, Kay Cavanagh, and Jason Moore. Susan Michelle volunteered to be on the committee, also

WORSHIP: We will leave our worship service behind the church building for now but may change it back to the front of the building because of the heat.

EDUCATION: The online registration for VBS is up and running. This year's theme is Food Truck Party. We may need a junior/senior high Sunday School teacher in the fall. The committee will not be doing the Easter breakfast next year.

EVANGELISM: The committee is sending out birthday cards, 2 in June and 1 in July. We will keep Jackie Walker in our prayers as she is in the Clinton hospital now.

MEMORIAL: Several ideas are being discussed about sprucing up the narthex and fellowship hall.

YOUTH: The Youth group went bowling and the confirmation class went kayaking. VBS is July 18-22, 2022.





Backwater Gamblers Water Ski Shows

Susan Michelle and Brigit Jepsen, Sabula, have been a big part of the Rock Island, IL Backwater Gamblers Water Ski Shows. The team has been in existence for 43 years. Susan Michelle has been a member for 41 and Brigit for 15. Brigit is 18. Both are members of our church.

Have you ever seen a ski show at Tommy Bartlett, Cypress Gardens or Sea World? The Backwater Gamblers offer a much bigger show, with more skiers, drivers, riders and announcers than a professional show...normally 3-4 times as many on most acts!

The best part is that admission is FREE! They perform water ski shows from Memorial Day through Labor Day at 5000 44th Street in Rock Island, on the Rock River. The shows are Sundays and Wednesdays at 6:30 pm. The show lasts one hour, with a short intermission, so plan on 90 minutes. Bleachers are furnished and there is parking near the river. Donations are gladly accepted at intermission, as the money helps pay for the boats, motors, gas, costumes, skis, ropes, speakers and a lot more. The 2020 ski season was cancelled, due to Covid-19, but the bills continued to come in.

What sport can parents and children do together? Not many, but show skiing is one of them. In addition to her daughter, Brigit and husband, Greg, being members, other family members that ski or have skied/driven boats in the past include her sister, Teresa Hofmann from Port Byron, IL, her husband (Richard), daughter (Morgan) and son (Joshua). Also add to that her brother, Randy Thompson from Bettendorf, IA and his wife (Val) and 2 daughters (Tristan and Tanner). Susan Michelle's dad and Brigit's Gpa Pinky Thompson, Port Byron, IL comes to almost every show to see his children and grandchildren ski. Susan Michelle, Teresa and Randy are all participating in the 2022 ski season. Brigit is taking the year off.

The themed show consists of 14 acts, including Ballet, Swivel, Jumping, Barefooting, Trios, Strap Doubles, Conventional Doubles, Around-the-Boat and Pyramids. The 2022 theme is Men In Black. Susan Michelle currently rides in one of the boats for the majority of the show, but does get out to help build the final pyramid on 2nd tier.

The picture in red costumes was taken in 2015, when Brigit was on the 3rd tier of the pyramid for the first time in a ski show. She is the 3rd tier girl on the far left. Her mom, Susan Michelle, is below her, 2nd tier on the far left. Teresa is on the 2nd tier, middle girl, of the 4-tier pyramid. Randy is 5th from the left



The team competes yearly against other show ski teams from around the nation. Currently they are ranked 1st in the Central Region and 5th in the Nation.

Some impressive acts from their history include 8 skiers Around-the-Boat – a world record in 1991 and a 5-tier pyramid. They were the 2^{nd} team in the world to successfully build 4 4-tier pyramids all behind one boat, which was accomplished in 2014. Susan Michelle was a part of that pyramid. She is 3^{rd} from the right on the 2^{nd} tier, in the blue and orange costumes. Teresa is 2^{nd} from the left on 2^{nd} tier. Randy is 3^{rd} from the left, 1^{st} tier. Brigit was not in the picture.



The final picture in the dark blue costumes is from this season. Susan Michelle is on 2nd tier on the far right. This was the pyramid that helped the Backwater Gamblers win the 2022 Central Regional title.

If you are looking for something different and unique to do, come and see a Backwater Gambler ski show and cheer on Susan Michelle. The shows are on **Sundays** and **Wednesdays** at **6:30 pm** at **5000 44th Street in Rock Island**. They'll be competing at the National Tournament on August 13th. The last show of the season will be Labor Day.
