Pastor Dave opened the meeting with prayer. Minutes from the previous meeting were emailed to members. Kris moved, seconded by Kathie, to accept the minutes as presented and the motion passed. Financial statements were handed out to members. Kathie moved, seconded by Ronda, to accept the statements as presented and the motion passed.

**TRUSTEES:** River City will come this week to inspect the boiler and turn it on. Tony Herrell was here and looked at the heat trace on the church roof. Johnson Plumbing serviced the sewer pump in the church basement. The Ring doorbell was not working so we purchased a Wi-Fi extender. We received a notice that the insurance premiums will be going up 12-18% next year. Our usual group of bike riders were here last week. Ronda will work on a policy for the groups that use the church building. According to the Safe Sanctuary guidelines everyone who has contact with children must have a background check on file. Snowplowing was discussed and noted that good communication is essential to keep our parking lot and sidewalks safe all winter.

**STAFF PARISH RELATIONS:** The meeting with our new district superintendent last week went well. October is Pastor Appreciation Month and we will have a reception for Pastor Dave on October 29th.

**FINANCE:** They are meeting Tuesday via Zoom. Our November communion offering will go to United Women in Faith.

**WORSHIP:** They will meet on Thursday and will start planning Hanging of the Greens in December. We had good comments on the church conference and potato bar.

**OUTREACH:** Last week's potato bar collected \$369. Everything was delicious! Trunk or Treat will be Sunday, October 29th from 5-6:30pm. Hot dogs, chips, and bottled water will be served. They will plan for a Souper Bowl luncheon in February. Vivian was instructed to pay in full the new program that replaced the Rainbow Covenant program.

**EDUCATION:** Things are going well. The children are doing a 4-week Fun-Sized Faith program and then will start preparing for the Christmas program.

**EVANGELISM:** Shirley Fritz had a birthday last month. Mary Irons called Sandy Pratt and had a good visit with her.

**INTERCHURCH COUNCIL:** There are new coordinators for the Savanna Christmas Children's Program, Zach and Brittney Castro.


**YOUTH:** A mission trip in July, 2024 has been planned to North Carolina. Confirmation classes are starting with 6 confirmands!


The meeting was adjourned at 12:40pm.


