Jesus said to Peter, one of his disciples, "I have prayed for you that your own faith may not fail, and you, when once you have turned back, strengthen your brothers." (Luke 22:32) Jesus knew that Peter will betray him and have a difficult time with his death. Jesus also knew that Peter will turn back to him again later. As we can see, Jesus knew pretty much everything about what would happen to Peter, yet Jesus had prayed to God for Peter that he may not lose his own faith in the difficulty.

According to a survey, 10 to 30% of church goers have not come back yet to in-person worship services after pandemic. To be better and faithful servants, we should take good care of ourselves and of what God has given to us. 2022 Stewardship sermon series will be delivered on the second and third Sundays in November. For the two Sundays, we are going to look at how we can use and handle our money according to the Scriptures. Please, don't miss this two weeks' stewardship sermon series!

We begin November as we give thanks for the saints who have gone on before – the men and women of First UMC of Savanna whose lives served as living letters from Christ to the world and to each of us. We will read in the service the names of those who have graduated to glory since last November, as we remember the ways their spirits touched ours and made of us who we are now. SAVANNA FUMC ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MINUTES SEPTEMBER 18, 2022 11:30AM CHURCH LIBRARY

Chairperson Susan Michelle Jepsen called the meeting to order at 11:20am with members Paula Mayer, Pastor Dave Yim, Molly Andersen, Kathie and Burt Prins, Bill Wright, Tom Michels, Pam Darrow, LaVona Grissinger, Mary Irons, and Jason Moore present. Pastor Dave opened the meeting with prayer. Minutes from the previous meeting were emailed to members. A correction was made stating we are returning to our hybrid worship service September 11, 2022. Susan Michelle moved, seconded by Bill, that we accept the corrected minutes and the motion carried. Mary moved, seconded by Pam, that we accept the financial report as presented and the motion passed.

STEWARDSHIP/FINANCE: Tom presented the budget for 2023. Kathie moved, seconded by Paula, to accept the budget as presented and the motion passed.

TRUSTEES: A representative from the Memorial committee, Linda Jachino, attended the meeting this morning to report on ideas for the narthex. A bid from Beckwith roofing for \$1726 was received to reline a trough on the church roof. Bill moved, seconded by Kathie, to accept the bid. Beckwith may suggest applying heating tape or other measures to address the roof leaks. Purchasing a leaf blower for the parsonage was tabled until more information is gathered. The Kitchen committee is getting 2 bids for the remodeling project. The pest problem at the parsonage has not been resolved yet. Pastor Dave will call the exterminator again. LaVona and Jason toured the parsonage recently. We are still waiting for an electrician to replace several lights inside and outside the church building. Pastor Dave has ordered new LED lights for the rest of the Sunday School rooms.

STAFF PARISH RELATIONS: Employees are receiving raises in 2023 to comply with Illinois' minimum wage law, \$15 per hour by 2025. Kay Cavanagh is back to working 15 hours per week. The church has a new phone system.

WORSHIP/HEALTH: The committee evaluated having outdoor services only during the summer and had some good comments. Vivian Eaton is checking into having another Oktoberfest at Manny's next month. All Saints' Day will be celebrated November 6th. Several comments about being inside again were shared, including having acolytes, the choir singing, and hearing the organ.

EDUCATION: There was no formal report but Sunday School started last week. LaVona led a craft for the children, tie dying t-shirts, and the shirts were being worn today and looked great! OUTREACH: They are meeting next Sunday.

EVANGELISM: We have 2 members having birthdays soon, Dorothy Taylor will be 99 on September 21st, and Janis Wilt will be 92 on September 24th. Janis will not be moving soon. Mary visited with the Torrisons, Susan MIchelle visited Bill Weidman, and Mary and Pastor Dave tried to see Glen Brunner but he was in the hospital.

MEMORIAL/HISTORICAL RECORDS: Members have been collecting ideas for remodeling the narthex and are meeting with Roger Husband this week.

LAY LEADERSHIP: Pastor Dave handed out the nomination form for 2023. Praise the Lord, we have chairpeople for every committee and no blanks on the form! Kathie moved, seconded by Paula, that we accept the nominations as presented and the motion carried. God is good!

UMW: Mary and Bonnie attended the district meeting in Pecatonica yesterday. Most district officers for 2023 have been found. Our local unit will have the same officers for 2023. We are having a chicken and biscuit take-out dinner on Sunday, October 16th, from 4-6pm.

UMM: They are meeting tomorrow night.




