I wish we could be more purposeful in supporting one another, discussing our issues with love, forgiving more, and viewing growth as our primary goal. I will call you to think about the lines below.

Chairperson Susan Michelle Jepsen called the meeting to order at 11:31am with members Vivian Eaton, Kris Yingling, Esther Losh, Pam Darrow, Tom Michels, Jason Moore, Kathie and Burt Prins, LaVona Grissinger, Molly Andersen, Ronda Rathje, Alexa Piercy, Mary Irons, and Pastor Fernando Candumbo de Castro present. Pastor Fernando opened the meeting with prayer. Minutes from the previous meeting were emailed to members. Kathie moved, seconded by Jason, to accept the minutes as presented and the motion passed. The Financial Report was presented. Vivian found a check from 2014 to Kathie Prins for paint, trim, etc. for the chapel but could not find any other records. April and Quinn Ruddell have been told to have their names added to the signature card for the youth account and Sharon Guilinger's name removed. Kris moved, seconded by Pam, to accept the financial report as presented and the motion passed.

TRUSTEES: We are still waiting for Jo-Carroll Energy to let us know about removing the electric pole on church property. After reading the building policy and questioning what the 4-H club would want to use for their meetings, Ronda offered to call Jane Shaw and find out more specifics. Kevin Cram is interested in having a concert at the church. It was suggested that he sing during worship or for the JOY ministry first. Our church will be used by the usual bicycle group overnight on October 6th. This is the evening of the UWF pulled pork dinner so the kitchen, parking lot and back door will be in use. The church's AED device will no longer be serviceable as the pads are being discontinued. A new device would be about \$1500. The church needs a string trimmer and leaf blower. Carlo Stubbe will be asked if he can fix our old ones that are no longer working. Our custodian, Kay Cavanagh, would like to clean out the basement of the church. Vivian has asked permission to have a vendor fair at the church and the committee okayed it. Susan Michelle moved, seconded by Ronda, to allow the vendor fair and the motion passed.

WORSHIP: The committee met on September 5th with community members invited, to discuss a Christmas concert. No committee has signed up to provide coffee time.

OUTREACH: Trunk or Treat will be October 27th. Several events are planned city-wide.

EVANGELISM: Dorothy Taylor and Janis Wilt have birthdays this month and we will have card showers for them. Pastor Fernando and Mary took communion to Yenneys and Pratts.

MEMORIAL/HISTORICAL RECORDS: They are meeting and plan on updating the memorial book in the narthex.

EDUCATION: The first day of Sunday School was well-attended and several grandparents came. We will have a joint meeting with the St. John Roman Catholic children in November and a Seder meal here in the spring, provided by Linda Jachino.

UWF: They met September 3rd to plan the upcoming pulled pork dinner. 
YOUTH: Alexa was welcomed as our new member.


