SAVANNA FUMC ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MINUTES SUNDAY, AUGUST 13, 2023 10:30AM CHURCH LIBRARY

Vice Chairperson Bill Wright called the meeting to order at 10:45am with members Kathie and Burt Prins, Kris Yingling, Jason Moore, Pam Darrow, Mary Irons, Tom Michels, Ronda Rathje, Molly Andersen, and Pastor Dave Yim present. Pastor Dave opened the meeting with prayer. Minutes from the previous meeting were emailed to members. Mary moved, seconded by Pam, to accept the minutes as presented and the motion passed.

FINANCE: Paula Mayer submitted her resignation as church treasurer, effective today. The committee recommends Vivian Eaton be our interim treasurer and the recommendation passed. Kris moved, seconded by Pam, to accept the financial reports as presented and the motion passed.

TRUSTEES: A new bid from Erickson Paving was received and forwarded to the Finance committee. Herrell Electric will be contacted about the church roof's heat traces before winter arrives and other projects. We will ask about a new project of placing a screen at the back of the sanctuary, also. The committee recommends we continue with River Cities Heating to service and maintain the boiler system. They are not certified but have years of experience with boilers and are a local business. Ronda checked with the insurance and as long as we maintain the boiler the insurance covers it. The recommendation passed. The committee also recommends we contact Johnson Plumbing to replace the lift pump in the downstairs bathroom in the church. There was a problem with the toilet overflowing during VBS. The recommendation passed. The awning used during the church picnic was damaged during a wind storm. Bob Grissinger, the owner, agreed to let the church continue to use it. The drive circle in the front of the church will be removed by Ron Miller. This will make snow plowing easier. Kay Cavanagh, our custodian, has found a new company to provide supplies, like floor wax, at a cheaper rate. Ronda was authorized to fill out the credit application for the new company. **WORSHIP:** We will have the Shirah Brothers give a concert next week during worship service. A luncheon will follow. It was asked to have the baptismal font moved for a better view of the sanctuary.

EDUCATION: August 27th will be Blessing of the Backpacks. Sunday School Kick-off is September 10th. VBS had 60 children and many helpers and the weather was beautiful! Praise the Lord! There will be a mission trip meeting next week.

EVANGELISM: Erik Torrison had a birthday in July. Carol Eyerly, Cori Moore's mother, has been moved to Big Meadows.

UWF: The August meeting was dinner at Deeann Kramer's home. They made plans to serve a drive-thru ham dinner in October.

MEMORIAL/HISTORICAL RECORDS: The trim in the narthex was painted.

UMM: They will be meeting next Tuesday. The church picnic was great!

PASTOR'S REPORT: Pastor Dave emailed his report to members. School starts this week and he asked what we could do to support our teachers. A suggestion was to serve them breakfast one morning. The school supply drive was a big success with several good ideas to improve it next year. Pastor thanked everyone for their dedication to so many mission projects. Our church conference will be Sunday, October 8th during worship. Committee budgets need to be turned into the office by Friday, September 23rd. Overall there is 20-25% of United Methodist churches leaving.
