For the past three months since I arrived in Savanna, all I see is something new or some changes; because I am fascinated by nature, I focus on what I have primarily noticed in the creation our God bestowed on us. In July, most of the land fields were clean, and a month later, they were very green as crops were growing; now, they are brown and ready for harvest. The massive numbers of trees around our town had their leaves all green and fresh; now, their leaves fall daily. It amazes me how God has established the natural cycle and how nature obeys the seasonal changes that happen yearly; soon, we will see many trees with bare branches. Isaiah 43:19 reads, "I am about to do a new thing; now it springs forth; do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert."

The Prophet Isaiah speaks a message of hope that focuses on redemption from captivity. And it is with hope that we are all called to see the changes around us, for the fall season announces winter, and winter announces Christmas, the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, the newborn King! May the Spirit of God give us open hearts and minds to perceive the new things God will do.

# SAVANNA FUMC ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MINUTES SUNDAY, August 18, 2024 10: AM @ CHURCH LIBRARY

Vice-chairperson Bill Wright called the meeting to order at 10:55am with members Ronda Rathje, Molly Andersen, Tom Michels, Kathie and Burt Prins, Linda Stubbe, Esther Losh, Deeann Kramer, Pam Darrow, Vivian Eaton, Jason Moore, Mary Irons, Kris Yingling, and Pastor Fernando Candumbo de Castro present. Pastor Fernando opened the meeting with prayer. Minutes from the previous meeting were emailed to members. Kathie moved, seconded by Pam, to accept the minutes as presented and the motion passed. Copies of the financial report were distributed. The 2025 budget was also presented. After discussion Kris moved, seconded by Jason, to accept the financial report and the 2025 budget as presented and the motion passed.

FINANCIAL: After discussing the deficit budget for 2025 discussion was held about the eventuality that we will not be able to afford a full-time pastor in a few years if member giving does not increase substantially. It was suggested that we let the congregation know we are already running at a \$63,000 deficit so far this year. It was also suggested that we go back to passing offering plates during worship to remind everyone to give. The September communion offering will go towards our Grief Share program.

TRUSTEES: They discussed the roof replacement at the parsonage and handed out copies of the only bid that was submitted, from Integrity Builders in Stockton. A recommendation from the committee to accept Proposal #2 at a cost of \$22,000-\$25,000 was voted on by a roll call of each member present, with a unanimous vote to accept the recommendation. The funds will be taken out of the endowment fund. Katy Cook would like to have a soup cook-off to raise funds for her Grief Share program at a later date.

Ron Miller offered to buy more books for her. The Carroll County Health Department will use our church building for a flu immunization clinic on October 2nd. JoCarroll has resurveyed the new electric line being installed and will have it done this fall. John LeComte, our legal counsel, looked at the contract from the state of Illinois for use of the church building for 4-H meetings. The contract is for a 5-year period and our contract would be for 1 year. It was suggested we update our building policy since we seem to have different charges for different groups using the church, or possibly getting rid of all fees.

**STAFF PARISH RELATIONS:** Our groundskeeper, Jeff Law, is resigning at the end of August. The committee met with a possible replacement candidate, Eric Jovin. The committee recommended the hiring of Eric at \$700/month for 7 summer months and \$400/month for 5 winter months and the recommendation passed.

**WORSHIP:** There seems to be less congestion in the narthex on Sunday morning with the ushers in the sanctuary. There is a silence reminder on the screen, Vivian plays the chimes, and the lights are dimmed. Each committee will take turns doing coffee hour and individuals may sign up also. The choir will sing on September 15th. Vivian has resigned from organizing the community Christmas concert and it has been suggested that Interchurch Council take it over. Comments were shared about standing for birthdays and learning Portuguese.

**OUTREACH:** They are meeting in September.

**EDUCATION:** Sunday School kick-off is next week from 11am-1pm. Sunday School starts September 8th with Grandparents Day. **MEMORIAL:** The daughters of Roberta and Mert Loomis were here looking at the chapel, a memorial for the Loomises. No records have been found regarding a plaque that was to be installed stating the chapel was a memorial for them. Vivian will check past statements and try to find the financial records.

**EVANGELISM:** Birthday cards were sent to Brenda Hamm and Sharon Guilinger. Visits were made to the Yenneys, Sharon Guilinger, Sandy Pratt at the Clinton hospital, Dorothy Taylor at Big Meadows, and the Pratt family at their home.

**UWF:** They will be going to Timber Lake Playhouse on September 10th. All women are invited.

**UMM:** Members and helpers cleaned the gutters at the Pratt home.



**PASTOR'S REPORT:** Pastor Fernando has been busy meeting with local people and committee heads. He is giving devotions at the Table on Wednesdays. His religious visa has been approved and paperwork is being submitted to get his family to the United States. LaVona Grissinger will call our local state representative, Toni McCombie to see if she can help. Rep. Eric Sorenson was contacted to help Pastor Fernando get his visa on a Friday and it was approved on Saturday! He is still learning many new things and is happy to listen to questions or comments.


