

From September 4th to September 20th, I will be flying back to South Korea to visit my father, who as been in a rehab facility since spring 2022. He suffered a brain stoke while he was sleeping and couldn't get up by himself. My mother found him in that condition one morning after returning from church, which was unusual as he would usually be awake by then. She immediately called an ambulance, and he underwent emergency surgery that morning. Since then, he has been taking intensive physical therapy. According to updates from my mother and sisters, he is showing gradual signs of improvement, although the progress is very slow.

I would like to express my gratitude to our church leaders for granting me this opportunity to visit my father and to the entire congregation for understanding, prayers, and encouragement. I kindly ask you to pray for my safe travel to South Korea and for my schedule while I am there. Additionally, I appreciate your prayers for the well-being and safety of my wife, Bang-Wool, and children, Jiho, Jiwon, and Jisung.

During my absence, Rev. Bonnie will be leading the service on Sunday, September 10^{th} , and Rev. Mike Jones will be preaching on Sunday, September 17^{th} . Your presence on those Sundays to support and welcome our guest preachers would be greatly appreciated. For any urgent pastoral needs, Pastor Bonnie Davies will serve as the emergency contact person. Please feel free to reach out to Pastor Bonnie or the church office for any assistance you may require. I will provide a report on my trip after my return to Savanna. Thank you once again for your support and prayers!

Sunday School Kickoff Day is scheduled for Sunday, September 10th at 8:45am. We have planned a fun activity that everyone can participate in, followed by a snack- sharing session from education committee. During the church service on the same Sunday, September 10th, the church choir will be performing, and we will also have special music presented by Ryker McCombie and Annika Law. Children's Time will also resume on that Sunday. We encourage you to bring your children and grandchildren with you on September 10th Sunday. Everyone is welcome!

SAVANNA FUMC ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MINUTES SUNDAY, JUNE 18, 2023 11:30AM CHURCH LIBRARY

Chairperson Susan Michelle Jepsen called the meeting to order at 10:59am with members Ronda Rathje, Molly Andersen, Tom Michels, Bill Wright, Mary Irons, Kris Yingling, and Kathie and Burt Prins present. Minutes from the previous meeting were emailed to members. Kris moved, seconded by Mary, to accept the minutes as presented and the motion carried. The financial reports were presented. April and Quinn Ruddell will be added to the signature file of the Youth Group checking account, #282294 at the Savanna-Thomson State Bank. The money left from the Youth Mission trip will be saved for next year's trip. Tom moved, seconded by Bill, to accept the financial reports and the motion carried.

TRUSTEES: Ronda had no luck with TMI in lowering their bill from last month. She presented copies of a contract with River Cities for maintenance on the church boiler and an estimate from Erickson Paving for blacktopping the church's parking lot. The committee recommends we accept the contract with River Cities and the recommendation passed. The estimate from Erickson Paving was tabled until next month. The Savanna Fire Chief, Scott Wolf, inspected the church building and Lectronics checked and repaired the fire extinguishers. The 40-year-old hot water heater at the parsonage sprang a leak last week and was replaced by Johnson Plumbing for \$1350. The Safety and Security committee will meet during the regular Trustees meeting. Our Safety Plan has gone into effect. We were reminded that the narthex monitor should still be welcoming to those who come to the door. Ronda has applied for 1 grant for security cameras and will apply for others in August. Some of the office file cabinet drawers have been locked since Ronda has sorted through them. The office desk lock is being fixed by Mark Rathje. NO ONE is to use the office computer. Jiho Yim has fixed the old computer and it will be available in the counting room.

FINANCE: The meeting scheduled for this Tuesday has been canceled.

WORSHIP: We celebrated Father's Day today. We will have a float in the 4th of July parade on July 2nd. Pastor Dave will be on vacation for the next 2 weeks. Rev. Patricia Allen-Stewart from Galena will preach next Sunday and Rev. Bonnie Davies will preach on July 2nd and provide pastoral care while Pastor Dave is gone. We will have a hymn sing on July 2nd with possibly Darren Mangler or Shelby Rathje. UMM will be hosting a church picnic on July 16th. Children's Time will be once a month during the summer. Plans are in the works for a Family Fun Night in August and new altar displays.

EDUCATION: VBS is July 17-21 and needs volunteers.


