FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH OF SAVANNA ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL SUNDAY FEBRUARY 19, 2017 11:30AM

Chairperson Burt Dauphin called the meeting to order at 11:36am with 11 members and 2 guests present. Pastor Joey Garcea opened the meeting with prayer. Peg Dauphin moved and Pam Darrow seconded a motion to accept the minutes from the January meeting and the motion passed. Vivian Eaton presented the financial reports. We have been asked to pay \$100 per month to the Elizabeth United Methodist Church for a parsonage charge. Peg moved and Kris Yingling seconded a motion to pay the \$100 monthly fee. The motion passed with 2 nays.

TRUSTEES: Paul Mayer presented the blueprint for the remodeling of the nursery bathroom to make it handicapped accessible. The cost was \$500. The committee recommends we approve the blueprint and the motion carried. Vivian bad a bill from Mediacom for the parsonage and since there is no cable service there Paul will check into it. He also called Kurtz Glass regarding the outside door replacement but they are unable to do the project. Joey has a friend from this former church who is a roofer and he will ask him to look at the leak in the church's roof. The church will look for volunteers to serve on a playground committee.

FINANCE: Randy Bonjour told about the work they have been doing to make a policy and procedures guide. The guide comes from the Book of Discipline and the committee recommends we accept the guide and the recommendation passed. Our scholarship fund is invested in Fannie Mae. He would like us to move that fund to ETO, Eaton Vance. The fund has a balance of \$13,836.09. Burt questioned the idea of the church having an account with this company and Randy will check with District Superintendent Lisa Kruse-Safford.

OUTREACH: Jason Moore said the Souper Bowl luncheon raised over \$400 and it will be donated to the mission trip going to Sager-Brown next month.

WORSHIP: Peg is the new leader of the worship committee. We will have a Mardi Gras service next Sunday. Lenten services will start on March 1, 2017, Ash Wednesday. We will host the service on Wednesday, March 22nd. We need volunteers to staff the nursery every week. A not will be in the March Telstar regarding the need for gluten-free communion sacraments. We may have someone interested in being our choir director but the position must be

Approved by the Staff Parish Relations committee. Jason moved and Kris seconded a motion to allow the committee to investigate the hiring of a choir director and the motion passed.

EDUCATION: Kris gave the report which included planning for a youth pastor, a REACH mission trip this summer, Pretzel Sunday on March 5, 2017, First Sunday movie this month, and gearing up for VBS in July.






