

TRUSTEES: Even though the committee is not meeting they have been busy. The air circulating pump on the boiler needs to be checked by TMI this fall. Two rooms have been cleaned out and the West Carroll School food pantry has moved into one. Weight Watchers has been moved to the other room and the sewing room has moved to the former Tween Sunday School classroom. Mark Cook put in 5 new outlets for the sewing machines. VBS supplies have been moved downstairs. Shelving will be purchased for storage bins downstairs. The memorial desk has been moved to the library and one bookcase has been removed from the library. Bob Davidson moved, seconded by Pam, to sell the extra furniture and tables that we no longer use, and the motion passed. LaVona Grissinger moved, seconded by Pam, to get our trailer back from the former boy scout troop leader and the motion passed. LaVona will call him and then we can decide what to do with it.

STAFF PARISH RELATIONS: LaVona reported Stephanie Shaw will be bringing her son, Dalton, to work with her on days when he is not in school. A new job description has been made for her.

EDUCATION/SCHOLARSHIP: We are hoping to have a Sunday School kickoff on September 13, 2020, along with Blessing of the Backpacks during worship. Hannah Guilinger is this year's scholarship recipient.

INTERCHURCH COUNCIL: The committee met Thursday and discussed many things, including the Christmas Kids annual party, Trunk or Treat, and Bridges opening soon.

UMW: Mary Irons reported on their last meeting, where they had a speaker from Riverview Center. The next meeting is September 1 and they will discuss plans for the annual bazaar and luncheon. The sewing ladies are meeting every Monday at 1pm.

PASTOR'S REPORT: Pastor Dave emailed his report to everyone. Many thanks go to the Law family, Ron Miller and crew, and neighbors and friends who helped clean up after the derecho storm on Monday, August 10th. A large tree came down on the church lawn and many smaller branches were broken around the yard. Vivian and Mary have spent many hours updating our membership files and mailed about 75 letters to inactive members. Mike Jones will be affiliated with our church in order to fulfill his duties to the district. Molly Andersen will be the coordinator of the West Carroll School food pantry. Pastor Dave's mentor is Rev. Marilyn Nolan from Lanark UMC. He will start his residency program next month via Zoom. We will have a work day on Wednesday at 9am and a Worship/Health committee meeting Thursday at 3:30pm.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:55am.

ADDENDUM:


