

vanna, IL, UMW members meet to put their have their own room in the church and it is stocked with sewing machines, yarn, material, notions, patterns, and plenty of good fellowship.

One of their first projects was setting up a prayer shawl ministry. This has been expanded to include lap blankets. The shawls and blankets are available in the church's narthex for whoever needs one.

This past year they have sewn hygiene bags for women and children who have used the services of the local sexual/domestic violence center, Riverview Center. Riverview Center provided a program at one of the UMW meetings and the bags were presented at the end of the program. A church-wide donation drive filled the bags with shampoo, soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste and other essentials. Some of the bags were also donated to the community food pantry. The Sewing Ladies repeated the effort with bags made from Christmasthemed material. This time the members of UMW took the bags home and filled them with personal hygiene products and these Christmas gifts were given to the West Carroll Scholl food pantry, which is located in the church building.

One of their big projects for 2020 was making pillowcases. Each pillowcase was unique. A beautiful pillowcase was given to each resident at Savanna's nursing home and the church shut-ins as a Christmas present. The UMW members wrapped and delivered every one.

When COVID-19 hit, the Sewing Ladies turned their talents and their material to making facemasks. The masks were donated to church members and throughout the community. They made 3 different sizes, including small ones or children.


