FUMC SAVANNA ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MINUTES

SUNDAY, MARCH 21, 2021 11AM

Chairperson John LeComte called the meeting to order at 11:12am. Members present were Pastor David Yim, Burt and Kathie Prins, Mary Irons, LaVona Grissinger, Vivan Eaton, Kris Yingling, Jason Moore, Molly Andersen, Susan Michelle Jepsen, Brennon Cavanagh, and Pam Darrow.

Pastor Dave opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes from the previous meeting were emailed to members. Susan Michelle moved, seconded by Kathie, to approve the minutes and the motion carried. The financial reports were presented. Susan Michelle moved, seconded by Mary, to accept the reports, and the motion carried. Vivian let us know our second PPP loan for \$15,795 was approved. Our utility bill for February was \$4300 due to the winter storms in Texas causing the price of natural gas to skyrocket. We have been given the option by Jo-Carroll Energy to pay our bill over several months.

TRUSTEES: TMI replaced some parts on the furnace and it's working! Praise the Lord! A verbal bid of \$985 was received for the replacement of the floor tiles at the end of the Education wing and under the dividing curtain between the sanctuary and fellowship hall. The committee is recommending we spend up to \$1200 once we receive a written bid and the recommendation passed. A church member was approached about the triangle piece of church property by the new owner of the L&M Motel. After much discussion it was decided to table the item until we receive an official request from the new owner. The committee also recommends loaning some of the fellowship hall tables to the Savanna Museum — April 16-18, 2021 and the recommendation passed. Kris moved, seconded by Vivian, to allow Susan Michelle to borrow tables and chairs for her daughter's graduation party in May and the motion passed. The committee also recommends allowing a framed 1968 cloth—calendar, donated by Cindy Law from her parents' estate, be hung in the church building and the recommendation passed. Bids will be sent out for several window replacements at the parsonage. Jason will look into getting a new electronic sign for the church yard.

STAFF PARISH RELATIONS: Bob Grissinger is resigning his position as groundskeeper effective April 1. Harry Grissinger will be replacing him. Susan Michelle moved, seconded by Vivian, to allow Pastor Dave to purchase a \$200 gift card for Bob and the motion passed.

WORSHIP: Mary showed us the new red and white paraments. The cost was \$100 less than expected thanks to Pastor Dave, who found them cheaper through a different company. The altar cloth is custom-made and will be arriving soon. They are beautiful! The radio channel for outdoor service was changed because of static on the old channel, and is working well. April 1, Maundy Thursday, will be a special service at 6:30pm in the Fellowship Hall. Easter

Sunday, April 4th, we will celebrate the baptism of Dalton Shaw and receive 2 new members, Stephanie Shaw and Melinda Dykema. Blessing of the Tractors, Lawnmowers, Motorcycles, and Bicycles will be April 18th. Blessing of our Pets will be May 2nd.

OUTREACH: The committee would like to be a Rainbow Covenant church again. Kris moved, seconded by Kathie, to spend \$100 each in each of the seven colors and the motion passed. They will host a soup and sandwich to-go luncheon on April 18th after worship service.

EDUCATION: Kris is working on providing Resurrection eggs for Easter to the children and sending care packages to our college students.

EVANGELISM: Mary has done some visiting with the Hamms and Alice Riffe.

SCHOLARSHIP: We are expecting 2 applications this year.

LAY LEADERSHIP: Jason will continue to chair the Outreach committee.

UMW: They will meet on April 6th and have a book review on social action. The district spring retreat will be April 24th via Zoom.

INTERCHURCH COUNCIL: VBS will be July 19-23 and will be held outside.

YOUTH: The West Carroll Masked Voice program has already raised \$10,000!

NEW BUSINESS: Susan Michelle visited with Bill and Letty Weidman and Bill remembers that we were bonded for the church's metal roof, and the last time we had the parking lot done was with the help of the county's connections. Molly asked permission to use the Fellowship Hall for Kids Kards on April 11th after worship and permission was granted.

PASTOR'S REPORT: Pastor emailed a copy of his report to members. An Easter letter will be mailed soon. He will be on vacation April 21-26, 2021, with Rev. Bonnie Davies filling in for him. He will be commissioned on April 24th at Barrington UMC. Congratulations, Pastor Dave! He will start his premarital counseling with Cheyanne Martelle and Glenn Hoffman on April 10th. This will be 4 sessions lasting 1-½ hours each before their wedding on June 26, 2021.

He closed the meeting with prayer and the meeting was adjourned at 12:17pm.


