Korea now, I would get emotional sometimes because I can't still believe that I am flying to S. Korea. I am deeply grateful for that God and FUMC family allowed me to be able to see my family in S. Korea. Thank you, God and FUMC family! I will be back to the U.S.A. with my family together and seeing you at church on 8/8 Sunday. Then, I will say thank you again on behalf of my whole family.

Lately, I am reading the book of Ezekiel. God had shown many visions to the prophet Ezekiel about the future of the Israelites. God said to him in visions that God will be punishing the Israelites for their abomination and their disobedience. God was very angry at the people of Israel and about their sins. God said in the visions that pestilence, famine, and war are coming and it will kill them. The reason to punish the tribes of Israel is that they forgot about God and worshipped idols. They made idols - all shapes and features from nature - out of wood and stone and bowed to them, saying they are our gods and they saved us.

I would like to share two very important things that I found in the reading with you. First, God called the prophet Ezekiel 'the Mortal' in each chapter. It reminds us that we are human beings, not a god. We are all dying. Life is short to love God and love others. Second, God had often said to the Israelites that they will know that God is the Lord through the pestilence, famine, and war. What came into my mind is that it would better for them and us to connect with God and stay in God's love before they and we met all the difficulties in life. In other words, God wants us to recognize God and fear God every day in our life, saying God is our Lord!


